BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is authorized to publish a legal notice to accept public bids for the operation of "Goat Hill" Golf Course for a period of one (1) year upon the terms and conditions contained in the lease, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town of Shelter Island reserves the unilateral right to reject any and all bids for whatever reason or justification it deems fit.

Roll Call Vote: 4 in favor 0 opposed

The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

RESOLUTION NO. 222

Supervisor Bliss offered the following resolution, which was seconded by Councilman Kane, to wit:

"Whereas", under the Last Will and Testament of S. Gregory Taylor, the remainder interest in "Taylor's Island" located in Coecles Harbor, Shelter Island, New York, was devised to the Town of Shelter Island, and

"Whereas", the said S. Gregory Taylor died on February 22, 1948, now, Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Shelter Island confirms that it did and does accept the devise of "Taylor's Island" as a public park to be known as "Taylor's Island Park" for the use and enjoyment of the general public subject to such reasonable regulations and restrictions which may be established by the Township of Shelter Island.

Roll Call Vote: 4 in favor 0 opposed

The resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.

The Supervisor proclaimed the week of November 26 through 30, 1979, to be Alcohol Awareness Week in the Town of Shelter Island.

On motion of Councilman Byington, seconded by Councilman Kane, general bills numbered 782 through 799 in the amount of \$1,135.71; highway bills numbered 194 through 197 in the amount of \$987.40; and federal revenue sharing bills numbered 213 through 228 in the amount of \$2,673.79 were ordered paid as audited. This motion was carried.
